Know ye, That James M. Kempe
a Corporal of Captain John C. Kennedy's
Company, ("G"), 13th Regiment of Illinois Cavalry
VOLUNTEERS, who was enrolled on the Twenty Fifth day of January
one thousand eight hundred and Sixty four to serve three years or
during the war, is hereby **Discharged** from the service of the United States
this Thirty First day of August, 1865, at Pine Bluff
Arkansas by reason of expiration of term under provision of Act of 3d March 1862 U.S.A.
(No objection to his being re-enlisted is known to exist.)*

Said James M. Kempe was born in Philadelphia
in the State of Pennsylvania, is 19 years of age,
5 feet 6 inches high, Fair complexion. Gray eyes,
Brown hair, and by occupation, when enrolled, a Farmer

Given at Pine Bluff Ark this Thirty First day of
August 1865.

in the conduct or physical condition of the soldier
rendering him unfit for the Army.
