CHESTER CO., SC

WILL of - John McClurken

In the year of our Lord 1813, I, John McClurken, of the district of Chester, and state of South Carolina, being in a middling state of health and of a perfect mind and memory, yet calling to mind my mortality, do make, constitute and ordain this instrument of writing, as my last will and testament, in manner and form following: As to my body, it is my will that it be buried in a decent and Christian manner at the discretion of my executors, and at the expense of my estate, and my soul I commit unto the hands of God who gave it, and as to that portion of worldly estate that it

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has pleased God to bless me with, I dispose of as follows:

First, it is my will that all my lawful debts be paid in the manner that will be prescribed in the sixth article of this will.

Second, it is my will that my beloved wife, Elizabeth, shall have a comfortable support out of the plantation I now live on. I also bequeath to her for her own proper use and and to be disposed of as she may think best, all the personal property of every kind that I am possessed of, with all my money, bonds, notes and book accounts, except what I now devise in the third, fourth, fifth and sixth articles of this will, to her and her heirs forever.

Third, I bequeath to my daughter, Sarah Trussell, the sum of \$1 to her and her heirs forever.

Fourth, I devise devise to my daughter, Elizabeth, that tract of land by the name of "My old place", lying on the south side of Rocky Creek, joining lines with Robert Gibson, Samuel Gibson, James McConnell, the Rev. John Hemphill and myself, this tract or tracts of land I devise to her and to the heirs of her body forever. I also bequeath to her my last spring's bay colt to her and her heirs forever.

Fifth, I bequeath to my daughter, Molly Gibson, the sum of \$1 to her and her heirs forever.

Sixth, I devise devise to my son, John McClurken, the plantation or tract of land I now live on containing two hundred (200) acres with the encumbrance on it mentioned in the second article of this will, said John (son) to pay all my lawful debts this tract of land with the proper appertainties thereunto belonging, I devise to said son and his heirs and assigns forever. I also bequeath to said son and his heirs forever, a sorrel mare called "His mare."

Seventh, I appoint, constitute and ordain my beloved wife, Elizabeth McClurken, executor of this my last will and testament and establish this and none other to be my last will and testament and disannull all other wills by me heretofore made, in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this day and year first above said. 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WILL of - Elizabeth McClurken

Know all by these presents that I, Elizabeth McClurken, the widow of the late John McClurken, deceased, being advanced in age, sick and weak of body, but of sound mind and memory and calling to mind my approaching mortality, do hereby make and publish this my last will and testament, the tenor of which is as follows, Viz:

First, I do commit my soul and body into the hands of my creator and redeemer thru eternity to be saved. I wish my body to be decently interred by my executor, and as for what I am possessed of as to the things of this world, I do hereby leave and bequeath the same as follows, viz:

First, I leave and bequeath unto my son-in-law, William Trussell, and his wife, Sally, the sum of \$2 and no more.

Second, I leave and bequeath unto my son-in-law, Samuel Gibson, and his wife, Molly, the sum of \$2 and no more.

Third, I leave and bequeath unto my son, John, \$100 in cash and a heiffer named "Star."

Fourth, I leave and bequeath unto my son-in-law, Robert Gordon, and his wife, Elizabeth all the balance of lent money belonging to me or in hand whether on the house or lent at present, and also a cow and calf to said Robert Gordon and his wife as aforesaid, and after payment of burial charges, debts, etc., I leave and bequeath unto my son, John, and son-in-law, Robert Gordon, all the balance of my worldly estate, share and share alike, to be equally and mutually divided amongst themselves and should they not be harmonious in the division, I allow all to be sold by my executor, and the net proceeds divided as above, share and share alike, and I do hereby nominate and ordain my son(-in-law?), Robert Gordon, to the only and sole executor of this my last will and testament as above stated, as witness my hand and seal this 17th day of December A.D. 1831.

__The following Information is taken from " Roster of South Carolina Patriots in the American Revolution, p. 603

McClurken, Thomas W21792 b. 1756, Ireland d. 22March 1845 m. Elizabeth Smith, 4 September 1790

During the winter of 1775 or 1776, he enlisted, while residing in Camden District, under Capt. Alexander Turner and Col. John Winn and was in the Snow Campaign. (CWM Note --Camden District was created in 1769 and was split in 1798 to Chester Co.) He was in the battle at Fort Moultrie. In late 1778 and early 1779, he was under Capt. Turner. In May 1780, he was under Capt. Lacey and was in the battle at Mobley's Meeting House on Little River. He served under Capt. Henry Hampton. During March 1781, he was under Lt. James Kennedy in the skirmish at the house of James Wylie. Also during 1781, he was under a Capt. Adams. In 1781, he was under a Capt. Cooper guarding the Orangeburg jail. He was in the taking of Friday's Fort and was under Maj. Wallace in a skirmish at Orangeburg. (Moved to Ill.) A.A.4934; A.A.4934A; T139; Y472" .

__From "Report of the Secretary of War, Washington, D.C."

Thomas McClurkin private in South Carolina Militia was placed on the pension roll Aug. 7, 1833. Pension began March 1, 1831, age in 1833 was given as 78 years.

__The Revolutionary service of Thomas McClurkin is recorded in the State Historical Commission, Columbia , in part, as follows:

"November 21, 1785...his account for 68 days duty as footman and 73 days as Horseman under command of Capt. Turner in 1779, 1781 & 1782.... Fifteen pounds, five shillings & 8 pence half penny Sterling....his account of Militia duty, 100 days Duty and provisions for public use in 1780 and 1781.... Balance charged L 271..10 Add Mon.... Currancy 272-10Str}....Sterling 38..18..6 3/4....."

__ His name is on a memorial erected to revolutionary soldiers of the Old Catholic Church near Chester, SC, which CWM visited and photographed in October, 1997.

__ The National Society of the Daughters of the American Revolution Volume 160, page 292: "Thomas McClurkin (1756-1845) received a pension, 1833, for service as private under different commands, 1776-82, South Carolina militia. He was born in Ireland; died in Washington County, Ill." .

Deed Book N, p.558 shows that Mary was his wife on 9 Nov. 1803.

__ He served During the American Revolution and was paid for 40 days as a prisoner of war.

__ The National Society of the Daughters of the American Revolution Volume 60, page 157: " Mathew McClurkin (1761-1847) was placed on the Indiana pension roll, 1840, for service as private, 1780 under Lieutenant Houston, Colonels Middleton and Sumter, and was in the battle of

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Hanging Rock. He was born in Ireland , died in Fayette County, Ind. ". The "War Pensins of Union County", show Matthew McClurkin, Private, Allowance \$20.00 Sum Recieved -0-, South Carolina Militia, Placed on Pension OcT 12, 1833, Age 70.

__ Fairfield Co. SC, Deed Book F, p. 47, Aug 18,1790, which reads, in part, as follows: "This indenture made the eighteenth day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & ninety & in the fifteenth year of American Independence between Alexander Gordon and his wife Sarah Gordon of Fairfield County, Camden District & State of South Carolina of the one part & Matthew McClurkin of Chester County District & State aforesaid of the other part witnesseth ... Now said Andrew Gordon & his wife Sarah Gordon hath bargained and sold unto the said Matthew McClurkin said tract containing fifty acres ... for and in consideration of fifty pounds sterling ... Signed, sealed & delivered in the presence of us, Alexander Gramham, Thomas McClurkin ... Sworn to me this 1st day of July 1797 ... William McQuiston J.P." (CWM Note: On the same date, Aug. 18, 1790, Alexander & Sarah Gordon executed a second indenture to Matthew McClurkin for an additional 200 acres of land on a branch of Rocky Creek for a sum of 100 pounds). CWM Note: I have both a transcription and a photocopy of the actual deed document.

__ His will transcribed from the LDS files of Miss Lois C. Myer by Charles (Butch) Sanders:

"In the name of the benevolent father of all, I Matthew McClurkin, of Prebble County, Ohio do make and publish this my last will and testament.

First: I give and devise and bequeath to my sons, James and John, each one dollar \$1.

To my daughters, Catherine Faris and Agnes Adkins, each one dollar \$1.

To my son Archibald McClurkin, \$100 and also my wearing apparel at my decease.

Second: I will and bequeath to my son, Joseph McClurkin \$280.

To my daughter, Jane Hamilton, \$200 and one feather bed.

To my daughter, Isabella Loudon, I give and bequeath \$200.

Also to my daughter Letitia Miller, I give and bequeath \$100, and to my daughter, Mary Ann Martin, I give \$100.

Third: And to my daughters, Jane Hamilton and Isabelle Loudon, I give and bequeath all my property and effects not named in this instrument and remaining unexpended at my death.

Fourth: I do hereby nominate and appoint Joseph McClurkin and Archibald McClurkin, executors of this my last will and testament hereby authorizing them to adjust and settle all claims against me and to collect all claims due me, and to pay the same over according to this my last will and testament.

In testimony of which I have hereunto set my hand and seal, this eighth (8th) day of April, eighteen hundred and forty-seven (April8 , 1847) Signed: Matthew McClurkin Witnesses: James Tuttle, Adam Spivey Written 4/8 1847".

Jennet McClurkin is the daughter of James McClurkin Sr. and Mary (McClurkin) Unknown. She was born Abt. 1766 in Ballymena Co. Antrim, Ireland. Immigration on 20 Dec 1772 in Charlestown, VA, Lord Dunluce from Larne, Northern Ireland. She died Abt. 1797 in Chester Co. ,SC.

Matthew Henry McClurken was her first cousin. After Jennet died in 1797, Matthew married again and moved West.

Chester County, SC Deed Book F, p. 142-143 records the sale of 50 acres for 100 pounds to Matthew and Jennet McClurken by Alexander and Sarah Gorden.

The will of her brother John, which was probated February 21, 1793, mentions sister Gennet's daughter Catherine, who was born in March, 1792 ; but not her daughter Nancy, who was not born until March 1794 .

New Alexandria, Penn.
June 29, 1896

Dear Nephew:

Yours of May 2nd, 1896, was received in due time; and I now proceed to give you what information I can respecting your and my ancestry.

Thomas McClurkin, my grandfather and your great-grandfather was about sixteen (16) years old, the time of the Revolutionary War. This I have from his own mouth. He said, "his father had a farm well stocked (in South Carolina) with cattle and horses, in Chester District. (They called the counties, districts.) The English camping near-by took all." Grandfather, being young and inexperienced, hearing they were about to move their camp, went to the chief officer to ask some pay for the cattle, but behold you, his response was "Get out of this place, you dog." And stamped his foot at him, and let down his brows. Grandfather said "he never was as glad in his life, to get away." Had the officer said the word he would have been shot on the spot. In those days there were many loyal to King George. They were called Torries. These helped the English to select a suitable place for encampment and in many ways encouraged them.

I never saw grandfather's Father or Mother. I do not know whether they had moved to South Carolina before Grandfather was born or not. It is evident they were of Scotch origin, as the name McClurkin indicated.

Of the cemetery you speak of, that my son John saw in Ireland, I have no knowledge. I will send him your letter and he can inform you what he knows about the matter.

Grandfather owned four (4) negroes: viz, Adam and his wife, Tine, and two sons, Isaac and Jacob. When grandfather joined the Covenanter Church, he set them free. Our Church never believed in slavery, always testified against it, and afterwards, the law of the State was so changed that no one could set his negroes free, however anxious to set them free they might be. This was the condition of affairs when we moved from South Carolina in December 1833. According to this date we landed at Archibald Hood's place after spending six weeks on the road in a wagon with four horses, and another one-horse carriage for grandmother and grandfather and their only daughter, Nancy McClurkin, my Aunt Nancy. We were the last of the McClurkins that moved away from South Carolina, the others had moved before us.

My grandmother was Smith, sister of old David Smith of Bloomington, Indiana. No doubt your mother may have seen him when she was very young, at least she had heard of him. At all events your mother knows the family of Smiths about Bloomington. My grandmother was Smith, sister of David Smith, John Smith, and James Smith, and also a sister, of Mrs. Donnelly, the wife of Rev. Thomas Donnelly, who was a preacher. These Smiths were born and educated in the principles of the Covenanter Church in Scotland and Ireland. I remember seeing my great-grandmother Smith when she was one-hundred and one (101) years of age, she lived with her daughter, Mrs. Thomas Donnelly. My grandmother McClurkin, being so well indoctrinated in the principles of our church, no doubt helped grandfather to see the evil of slavery and join the Covenanter Church. Because he did so, he incurred the displeasure of his neighbors. Evidence of this we have in the way he was persecuted. Four times in succession, through spite work, he was subpoenaed to sit in court as a jurymen. This they knew he could not do, consistently with the position he has just

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professed as a Covenanter, consequently he paid his fine, which was twenty (20) dollars, and four times this, is eighty (80) dollars, which they took out of his pocket, because he did not join some of the slave-holding churches; such as the Secession Church or the Associate Reformed, or the Presbyterian. These churches were many, if not all, originally from Ireland and Scotland, and all opposed slavery at first, but fell in with slavery because the Constitution allowed and sanctioned it.

Grandfathers family consisted of the following children; viz, John, my father, the oldest; Archibald; James; Thomas; David and Nancy. All are now dead and buried in the same graveyard near Oakdale, Illinois, which used to be Elkhorn Cemetery. My father and mother died in 1874, only three or four days between their deaths. I ought to exempt Uncle Archibald McClurkin, for I remember that he was buried in Pinkneyville, near Chester, in Illinois. I suppose all his family that is now dead are buried there. All these deaths remind me that I am the oldest McClurkin now living of which I have any knowledge.

Matthew McClurkin, a brother of Thomas McClurkin, my grandfather, moved from South Carolina before I was born. He raised a large family in Ohio, in New Light Covenanter Church, some of whom moved to Iowa, near Morning Sun, and others went to Princeton, Indiana.

Grandfather had four or five sisters or more, Mrs. McClure, and Mrs. Blair, whom I have seen. The Blair family lives near Adamsville, in Mercer County, Pennsylvania. The McClure family has moved to Iowa, near Morning Sun.

I am living a retired life, being put on the retired list of old super-annuated ministers. I am eighty-four (84) years old. I am trying like Moses to ascend Mount Pisgah to see the heavenly Canon, or like the worthies in Hebrew 11th Chapter, I am a stranger and pilgrim seeking a better country.

Mrs. McClurkin joins me in sending her regards to you all. Your mother knows that her maiden name was Ewing, daughter of Robert Ewing. Please answer me.
