

The Late Powell Howland.

The last will and testament of the late Powell Howland was admitted to probate yesterday. The executors named in the will are Eliza J. Howland, Charles A. Howland and Oliver Johnson. The testator leaves property to his widow, Mahala Howland, valued at from \$40,000 to \$50,000. To each of his sons, Morris Howland, Eliza J. Howland and

Charles A. Howland, he leaves a legacy of about \$20,000, and to his daughters, Fanna Clements, Fannie Johnson and Martha F. Hammond, he leaves a legacy of about \$15,000. To his granddaughter, Mary E. Lowe, he leaves property of the estimated value of \$1,000. After the payment of the foregoing legacies there will remain to divide equally between his children, property estimated at about \$100,000. The homestead and 20 acres of the land, and everything pertaining to the business of farming, is left the widow.
